## Saving water – water is very valuable for our island because of climate change and not sufficient rainfall

- Make sure any water taps are completely turned off when not in use
- Do not let water run unnecessarily
- Take showers rather than baths
- Re-use your bath/pool towels and leave them on the floor only when they really need replacing
- Inform the reception immediately about toilet/bath leaks

## Saving energy

- Close all windows and doors when the air condition is in use
- Turn off the lights and air condition when leaving the room
- Avoid leaving room devices on standby when not in use
- Avoid overcooling the room (26°C is an ideal room temperature)
- Unplug your personal device chargers when they are not being used
- Prefer natural light to artificial lighting
- Turn off electrical devices when they are not in use
- Inform the reception immediately about electrical malfunctions for prompt repairs
